

OSAP: Checking Your Status

The Financial Aid Office is currently processing confirmation of enrolments to prompt the release of OSAP funding to eligible students. Once your confirmation of enrolment has processed, it will take 4 to 10 business days for your funding to arrive in your bank account. Your confirmation of enrolment cannot be processed if any of the following apply to you:

- **You are not registered in a full time course load**
- **You have outstanding documents on your OSAP file**
- **Your program information on your OSAP application do not match your school records**

Please note that the Financial Aid Office will automatically correct your program information during the confirmation of enrolment process – you do not need to submit a change request to update your program information

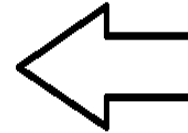

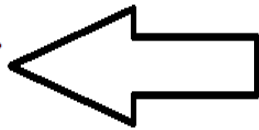
