

Payment Information – OSAP Students

If you are receiving sufficient funds from OSAP to pay your full semester tuition, OSAP will pay Durham College directly when your funds are released

- Please ensure all required documentation is submitted to your OSAP application
 - Confirmation of enrolment will occur automatically on completed OSAP applications after the study period begins which will prompt the release of funds
 - Once the COE is confirmed, OSAP money will deposit in 4 10 business days




