



How to Access Your OSAP Estimate

1. Log in to you OSAP account. Click on ‘Go to my part-time apps’ tab.

1. Search for the course webpage for every course you intend/are enrolled in. All PPL courses are accessible by scanning the QR code.

2. Scroll down to the bottom of the course description until you see the Scheduled Dates section. Add all your course(s) 'domestic fee(s)'. Input the total as your tuition.

3. You must be taking a 20–59% of the course load to remain eligible for part-time OSAP (typically 2–3 courses per term). Email Financial Aid and Awards (financialaid@durhamcollege.ca) to have your course load calculated.
