All counsellors and staff members involved in student recruitment and support are required to complete the Ontario Public Colleges Agent Training module. This training is essential to ensure alignment with provincial standards.

If the training has not been completed, your contracts with Ontario colleges may be impacted.

Training Details:

- **Module:** Ontario Public Colleges Agent Training
- **Launch Date:** December 5th, 2025
- **Deadline for Completion:** June 5th, 2026
- The module can be completed in around 30 minutes

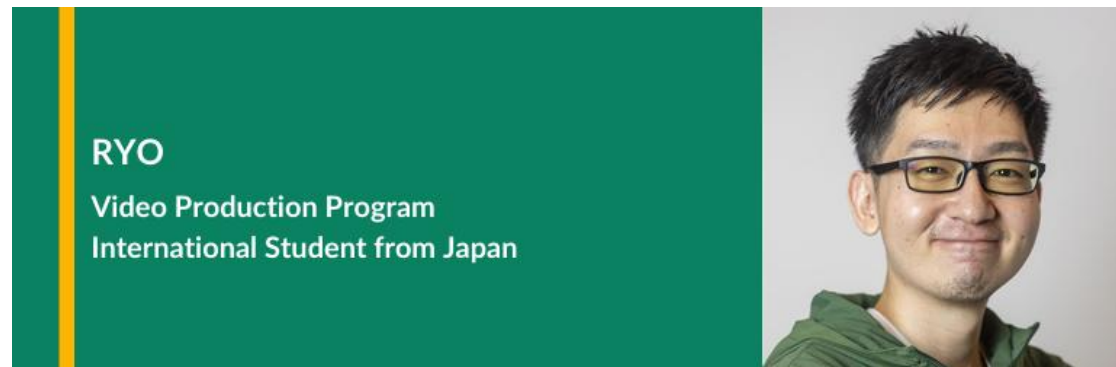
Upon successful completion of the training, participants will receive a Certificate of Completion with a unique identification number. The status of your completion will be published on a public website as part of the transparency and accountability measures under the Standards of Practice. If you have an active agreement with multiple Ontario public colleges, you only need to complete the training once.
