TUITION & FEES

The average cost of tuition and fees is \$16,000 CAD per academic year for most programs. For specific program costs, visit durhamcollege.ca/programs.

SCHOLARSHIPS

International students commencing programs at Durham College will be eligible for a variety of scholarships that can offset the cost of your studies. The awards are open only to new full-time international students in their first program of study.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIPS

Students who achieve academic excellence in their program of study may be awarded an in-course scholarship valued up to \$1,000 CAD. We're proud to share that 27 international students were recipients in the 2022–2023 academic year.

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY SCHOLARSHIPS

Individuals are automatically assessed for this scholarship during the application process. Students with a higher English proficiency score are eligible for a scholarship of up to \$1,500 CAD.

Durham College staff will assess each student based on their English scores. Successful recipients will be notified during their first semester by email. The funds will be applied to your account towards your second semester fees. Scholarships are non-renewable.

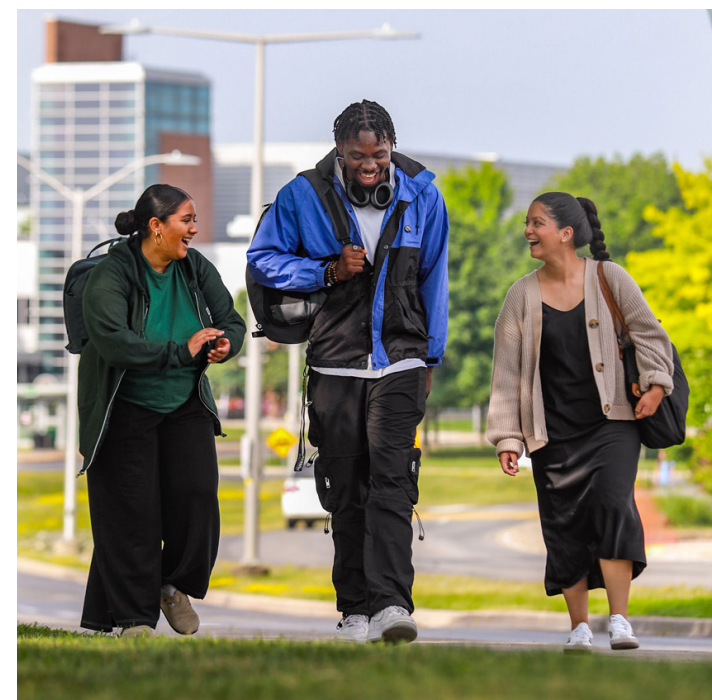

STEP FOUR: CHECK YOUR APPLICATION STATUS

STEP FIVE: ACCEPT YOUR OFFER

Once you receive your letter of acceptance, confirm your seat, and pay your first semester fees as soon as possible through your DC International self-service application portal.
