 - Apply online on job search websites
 - Network ask friends, teachers and others you know for leads
- Resumé and cover letter should be tailored to positions
 - You may be required to complete an online application as well as upload a resume for a job

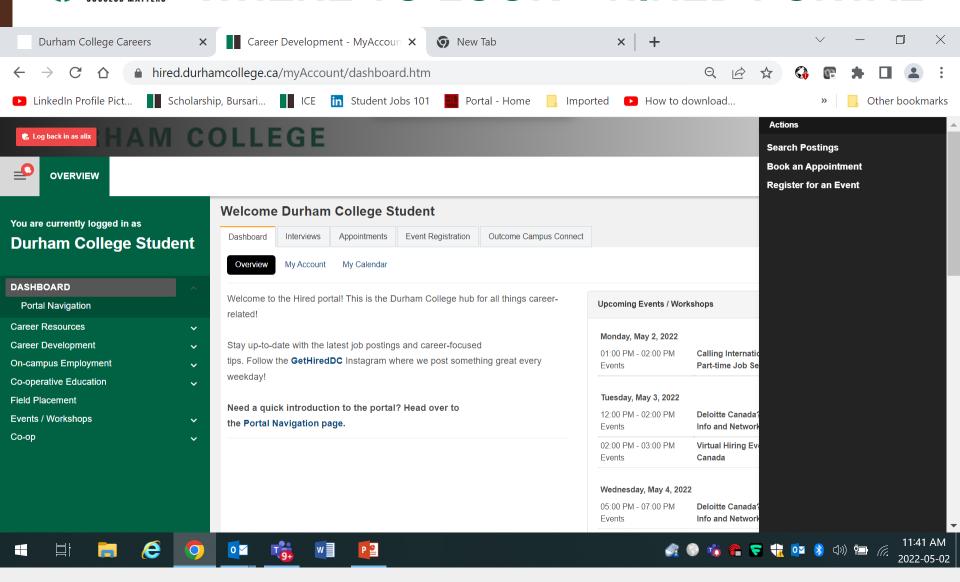

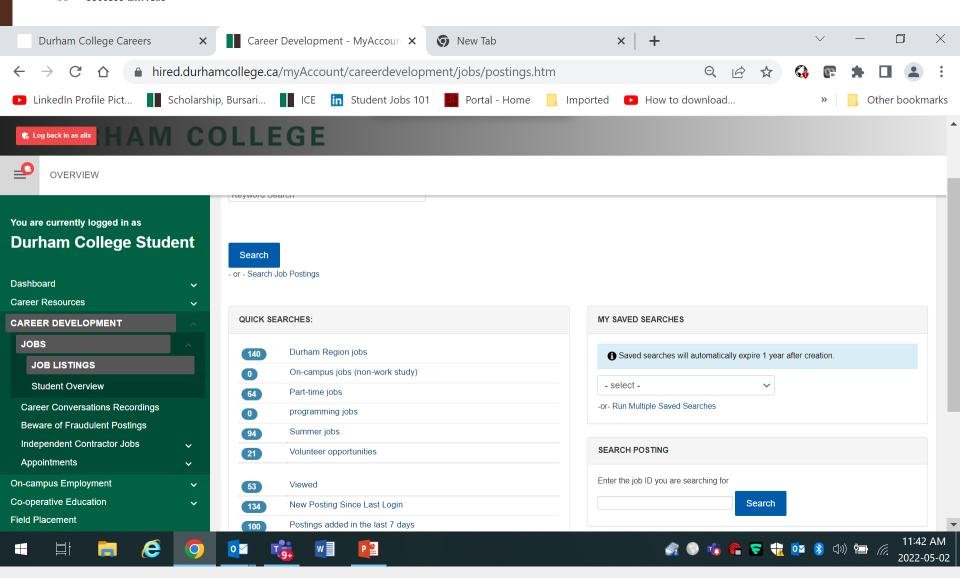

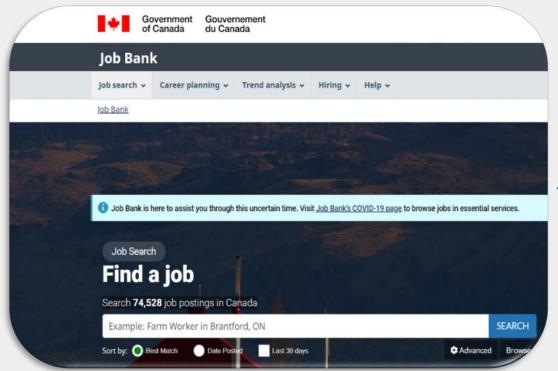

- Be paid minimum wage for their work
- Hours of work and overtime
- Have a safe workplace

JOB SCAMS

How not to be Scammed

- Are you offered a job without an application or interview?
- Does the employer conduct the interview through texting, PM or DM?
- Does the company ask you to pay for something before you start working?
- Does the "employer" send you money or cheques and asks to use your bank account?
- Does the "employer" promise high pay for not much work?
- Is the job description vague? Does it not require experience or specific skills?
- Is the company or contact information missing or vaguely presented?
- Does the employer use an unprofessional email address?
- Do the "employer" search results add up?
- Does the job posting sound too good to be true?
- If in doubt. Ask! We are happy to help!





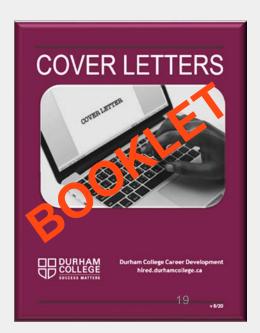
WHAT TO DO IF YOU ARE SCAMMED

- Gather all information about the fraud
- Contact your financial institution
- Contact the police
- Report the incident
- Protect yourself from future fraud



COVER LETTER

- Not typically used for part-time work
 - Can be a great way to stand out
- Gives more detail about you:
 - Why you're interested in the position or business
 - Highlight your skills/experience related to the position





RESUMÉ

DO NOT INCLUDE:

- Photo
- Marital status or family information
- Parents' names
- Birth date or age
- Social Insurance Number (SIN)
- Passport number
- Work permit information



RESUMÉ

Contact information

- Name, email and phone number

Objective

- Seeking part-time work, times available

Education

- Current Durham College program
- Previous education

Relevant Skills

- List of 4-6 strengths you have

Past experience

- Paid work, volunteer work, extra-curricular activities

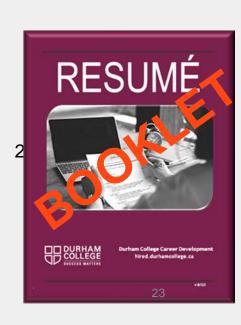

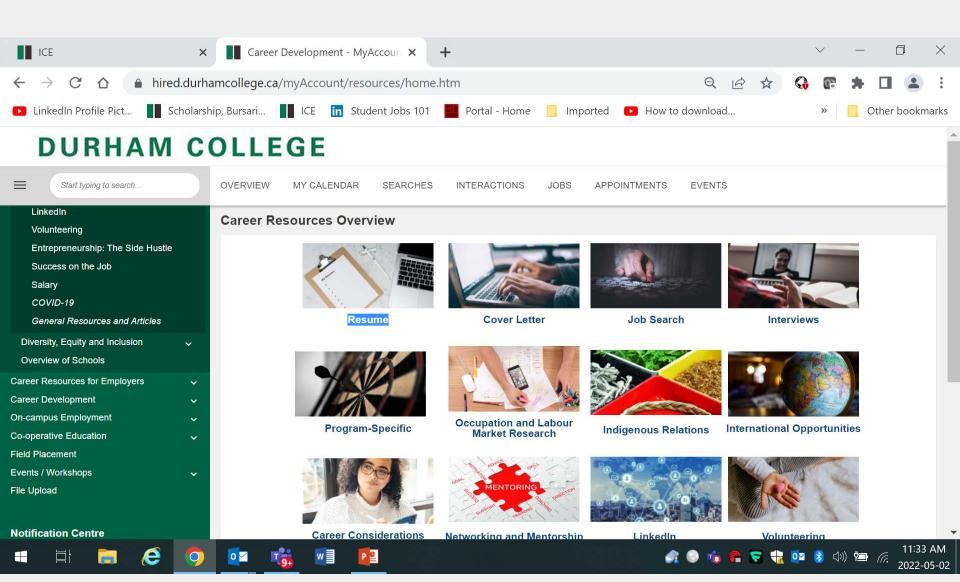

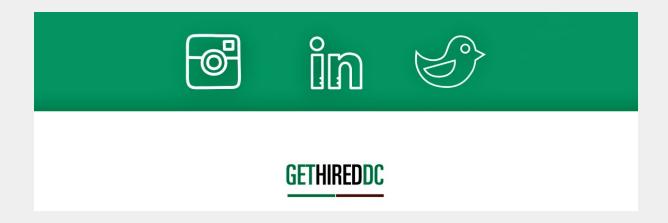
